

## Tennessee Bureau of Workers' Compensation (TNBWC) EDI Claims Release 3.1 Announcement

## TNBWC Trading Partners Changes to DN0154 Employee ID Assigned by Jurisdiction

To: TNBWC Trading Partners

Please be advised that effective August 12, 2021, the edit applied to Employee ID Assigned by Jurisdiction (DN0154), which matches the date of birth entered as part of this data element to the Employee Date of Birth (DN0052), has been removed. At this time, the Bureau recommends that the Employee ID Assigned by Jurisdiction (DN0154) continue to be entered as the number "9" followed by the employee's date of birth in the format 9MMDDYYYY in cases where the use of this data element is necessary; however, if another unrelated claim has previously been accepted by the Bureau using the same value for DN0154, the record will be rejected and you'll need to contact the Bureau by email at <u>tnbwc.edi@tn.gov</u> to have a new value assigned for that data element that will NOT include the employee's exact date of birth. TNBWC trading partners should ensure that the Employee ID Assigned by Jurisdiction (DN0154) data element can be updated in their system to allow a new value that is not required to exactly match 9+DOB.

TNBWC is considering ways to better address these claims and will note any further changes to Employee ID when v1.6 of the requirement tables are published; however, until then, please be aware of this need to potentially update DN0154 to a value other than an exact match to 9+DOB and ensure that your system will accept this new value.
