



Tennessee Bureau of Workers' Compensation (TNBWC) EDI Claims Release 3.1 Announcement
STATE OF TENNESSEE—EDI Release 3.1 Dry Run Processing Update

October 27, 2020

As noted in the previous reminder, Tennessee's EDI Claims R3.1 Implementation date is Oct 27, 2020. Any Release 1.0 files sent to TNBWC after Oct 26, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. CT will not be processed or acknowledged and must be reformatted to Release 3.1 and sent to ISO.

Dry Run Processing

Due to the need to send the Employee Security ID on any subsequent FROIs or SROIs, TNBWC will perform the Dry Run processing in two parts. TNBWC/ISO will perform Part 1 of the Dry Run processing for R3.1 using FROI production data beginning on Tuesday, Oct 27, 2020. Production data will be reviewed and analyzed for several days and any Trading Partner Profile issues will be identified. Once FROI issues have been reviewed and analyzed, all FROI acknowledgements will be returned for data that has been submitted up to that time. Acknowledgements for accepted transactions will include JCN's and Employee Security IDs. TNBWC encourages all Trading Partners to then utilize this information to send SROI production data.

TNBWC/ISO will then perform Part 2 of the Dry Run processing for R3.1 SROI's and any subsequent FROI's as well as any new FROI's sent. We will evaluate all filings and will identify any Trading Partner Profile issues. We are targeting Monday, Nov 9, 2020 as the day we return acknowledgements for Part 2 of the Dry Run testing and for any files received since Part 1 Dry Run acknowledgments were sent.
